As a part of the digital community I have the Right to be and feel safe online.

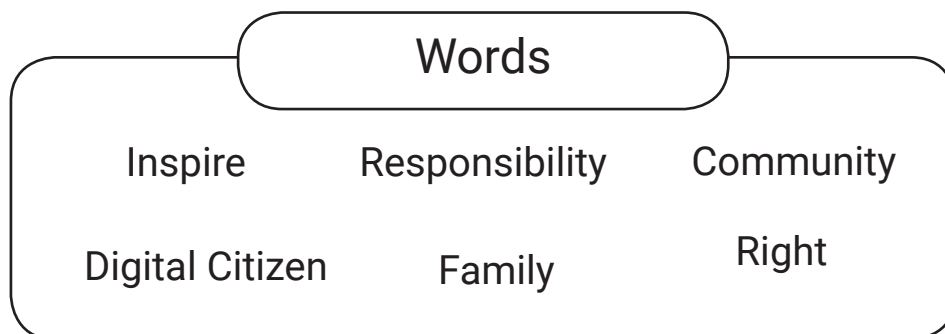
When I participate and contribute content online I am a Digital Citizen.

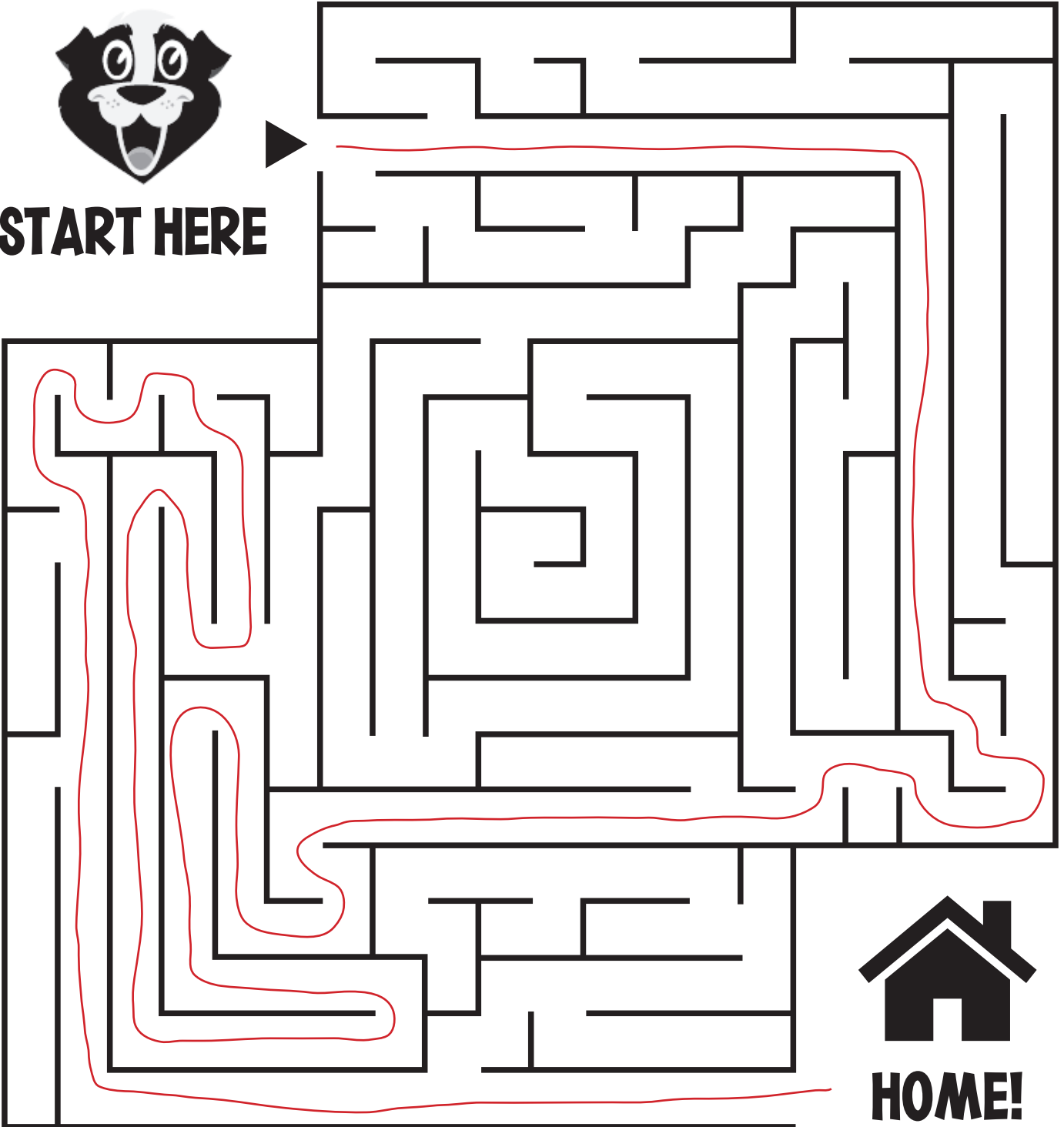
