

Web Lab #2

This lab will introduce some new elements in coding that will provide structure for your page when we style them. Remember to validate your page with the W3C validator. Please note that if you wish to work on any page at home you can use either notepad or notepad ++ (Windows) or Textwrangler (Mac) to edit your code, both are free to use.

Instructions:

1. Open Dreamweaver and a new webpage (a template can be found on Edmodo)
2. Change your `<title>Lab 2</title>`
3. In the body of your page make a `<div></div>`
 - a. This element is a box and is used to organize parts of your pages into different sections.
4. Inside the `<div>` element insert a `<h1>Navigation</h1>` and a `<p></p>` and fill them with some content.
5. Add another `<div></div>` after the first div box and inside this one element insert a `<h1>Content</h1>` and a `<p></p>` and fill them with some content.
6. Add another `<div></div>` after the second div box and inside this one element insert a `<h1>Footer</h1>` and a `<p></p>` and fill them with some content.
7. Save this in your folder and keep this file for future labs.
8. Turn in after validating your webpage to Edmodo.

Tomorrow we'll look at inserting an image into our webpages. Remember to validate your page before submitting it for marks.
