

Web Lab #3

This lab will guide you through inserting an image into our web pages. Inserting images into our pages takes a few steps to prepare before actually writing the code. These include setting up an organized file structure so everything will be organized, downloading and naming your pictures you wish to use, and resizing and/or cropping your images so they are only as big as they need to be.

Instructions:

1. First make a folder that will house your website.
2. Have your index.html page in this folder
3. Make another folder in that folder and call it, "images"
4. Then download and move your images into this images folder
5. Rename your images to something easy.
 - a. Please use all lowercase letters and NO spaces.
6. Edit your pictures so that they are the following sizes.
 - a. 100px x 150px
 - b. 200px x 150px
 - c. 300px x 200px
 - d. 640px x 480px
7. Keep your originals for another lab.
8. Time to code!! Open your web page from your previous lab.
9. In the content section of your page make a `<p></p>` element and insert
 - a. ``
10. Repeat step #9 for each sized picture.
11. Validate your webpage and submit your page to Edmodo.
 - a. To submit both your pictures and web page please compress your website folder into a zip folder and submit that.
