

Web Lab #4

This lab will teach you how to create links in your web page. Links can be used to find another page in your website, jump to a particular spot on your webpage, and link to other websites. Links can be made out of images or text.

Instructions:

1. Open your webpage from your last lab.
2. Create 4 links to do each of the following
 - a. Jump to the top of the page
 - b. Link to another website
 - c. Link to another file on your computer (an image, flash file, PDF)
 - d. Use an image as a link
3. To make a link make a `<p></p>` element and inside that type `Name of Link`
 - a. This one is set to go into a folder called images and find an image called goof.
4. To make a link to go to the top of the page is simpler, type `Top`
 - a. Since nothing is typed in the address area the default is to select the current page and go to the starting position which is the top of the page
5. To make a link that finds another website type this:
 - a. `Google`
 - b. The `http://` tells the browser to search the internet for this link
6. Lastly to use an image as a link uses the same rules for making an image from yesterday's lab
 - a. ``
 - b. If you want to add text as well include `
` 'Name' after the closing of the `img` tag and before the end of the ``.
7. Placement of links – the link that takes you to the top of the page should go in your footer area.
8. The link that takes you to another website should go in your navigation area
9. The other two links can be either in your navigation area or content area.
10. Lastly, validate your webpage.
11. Compress your website folder and submit it to Edmodo.

Next we'll examine links to specific areas of your webpage and identifying elements on your page and why we do that.
